# Good intuition #2

Scripture is meant to give us wisdom about what is good

Psalm 104:13-15

[God] waters the mountains from his upper chambers; the land is satisfied by the fruit of his work. He makes grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people to cultivate, bringing forth food from the earth: wine that gladdens human hearts, oil to make their faces shine, and bread that sustains their hearts.

Proverbs 31:4-7

It is not for kings... to drink wine, not for rulers to crave beer, lest they drink, and forget what has been decreed, and deprive all the oppressed of their rights.

Let beer be for those who are perishing, wine for those who are in anguish!
Let them drink and forget their poverty and remember their misery no more.

John 2:10-11

<sup>10</sup>and [the banquet manager] said, "Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but *you have saved the best till now*." <sup>11</sup> *What Jesus did* here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory...

Ephesians 5:18

Don't get drunk with wine, which leads to ruin...

1 Timothy 5:23

Stop drinking only water and have some wine, because of your stomach and your frequent illnesses.

#### 2 Timothy 3:15-16

...from infancy you have known the sacred scriptures, which *are able to give you wisdom* about the rescue that comes through trusting in the Messiah, who is Jesus.

All scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, challenging, correcting and training in what is right, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for doing every kind of good.

# Good intuition #3

Scripture is the place where we learn to <a href="https://example.com/hear">hear</a> God

Psalm 1:1—3

Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers.

#### Psalm 1:1-3

Instead, their delight is in the instruction of Yahweh, and they <u>meditate</u> on his instruction day and night.

That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither, whatever they do prospers.
